The CoRWM workshop on 30 October 2008, Reading

In e-bulletin no. 24 we told you about a forthcoming CoRWM workshop in Reading on 30 October. We said that attendance would be by invite only, but that there would be some spaces for those with an interest who wished to nominate themselves. A few more details about the workshop

We expect the workshop to start at 10am prompt and finish no later than 4.30pm. The day will be divided in to a number of breakout sessions, each of which will address specific questions corresponding to the following areas of our work:

- Research and development
- Safe and secure interim storage
- Implementing geological disposal
- Government's Managing Radioactive Waste Safely programme

There will also be a plenary session to discuss CoRWM's engagement with others and to obtain feedback on our public and stakeholder engagement so far. The detailed questions and briefing material will be sent to participants before the event, as well as being posted on the website.
